1. The table below shows the number of seats in class - I for session 2018-19:

- 2. All children admitted as day scholars in Class I in 2018 will compulsorily have to become day boarders when they reach class VI in April 2023. This means they will have school timings extended till evening games and will be served lunch and evening snack in school. This will entail an additional fee.
- 3. Number of seats for day scholars in Class II is over 100. Preference will be given to applicants in the sibling category.
- Copy of Birth Certificate issued by the Municipal Corporation or competent authorities necessary. Date of birth will not be changed later under any circumstances.
- 5. A candidate will be considered in a single category only. e.g. if she is the daughter of Ex-MGDian and also has a sister studying in the school, she can't come under both Alumni and Siblings.

^{*}these seats will be kept vacant up to 7 July to accommodate transfer cases

- Admission for class I and II: There will be no Entrance Test or Interview. A
 Public Draw of Lots will be held on 15 February 2018 on the school campus in
 the presence of school authorities.
- 7. Admission for class III to VIII: Day scholars will be admitted only if there is a vacancy in the class. For boarders, admission will be on the basis of promotion result of the previous class, interview & interaction with the parents at a mutually convenient date.
- Admission for class IX: An entrance test will be conducted on 12 January 2018
 on the school premises for boarders only, followed by an interaction with the
 candidate and parents. There will be three papers in English, Maths & Science
 of one hour duration each. The candidates will be tested on the syllabus of
 class VIII.
- Admission for class XI: for both boarders and day scholars will be on a
 provisional basis in April and will be based on the Pre-Board result of class X
 and an interaction with the candidate and parents. It will be confirmed in May
 only after the declaration of the Board results.
- 10. There will be no admission in class X and XII
- List of selected candidates in class I and II will be displayed on the school notice board and school website i.e. <u>www.mgdschooljaipur.com</u> on 15th February 2018. For all other classes, selected candidates will be intimated individually by email.

12. Re-registration for Class XI

Students of class X of MGD have to re-register for class XI. No additional fee is charged, but conditions apply with regard to conduct and academic motivation.

13. Last Date for submission of duly filled registration form for class XI (day scholars) is Wednesday, 28th March 2018 by 12.00 noon. A candidate is required to submit a copy of Board result as soon as the result is declared. New Session for XI will commence one week after to the school session.
